

Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Temporary Road Closure

B5132 Stanney Lane in the Parish of Ellesmere Port Town Ward

Notice is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit traffic on the following lengths of roads in Ellesmere Port Town Ward to enable carriageway resurfacing works to be carried out by Cheshire West and Chester Council.

Stanney Lane - from its junction with McGarva Way to its junction with Vale Road.

Nothing in the Order shall prevent driving upon the said lengths of road of any vehicle which is being used for the conveyance of persons goods or merchandise to or from any premises situate on or adjacent to the lengths of road or in connection with agriculture building construction works of repair and the like or use in an emergency of vehicles for fire brigade ambulance or police purposes. A through route will not always be available and any vehicles not requiring access to properties on the length of road should use alternative routes.

The closure will come into force on 30th April 2019 and will be in force for a maximum of five days. It is anticipated that the work will last for approximately five days.
